SCIENCE Expo: Innovating for a Sustainable Future

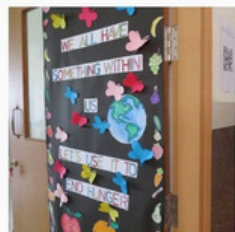

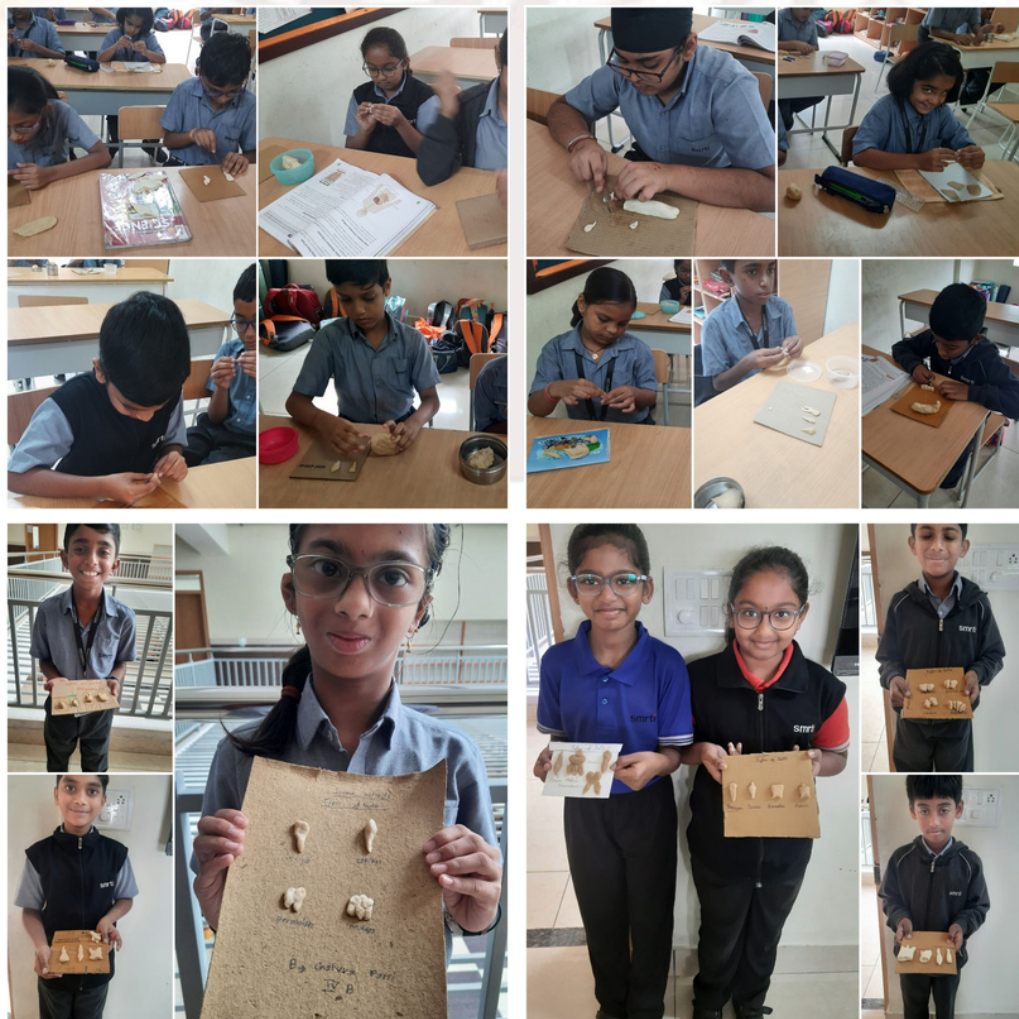


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Types of Teeth

Nurturing Inclusive Classrooms – CBSE Gender Sensitivity Training

Students of Grade 4A and 4B explored the different types of teeth as part of their lesson on digestion. To deepen their understanding, they engaged in a hands-on activity where they sculpted and labeled the various types of teeth using clay made from atta dough, avoiding the use of chemical clay.
